Title: **St. Lucas Sunday Welcome Center Samaritan**

Major Duties:

1. Attend a training event and building orientation to be fully equipped for the ministry of welcoming.
2. Staff the Welcome Center for a 40-50 minute period (8:30-9:10 AM or 10:00 AM to 10:50 AM) one regular Sunday each month. (For example: first Sunday or second Sunday each month).
3. Direct or guide as needed, members and guests to their destinations. Be alert for people who may need help and be proactive in offering assistance.

Time Commitment: One hour for initial training and 40-45 minutes one Sunday morning each month.

Gifts, Talents, and/or Special Skills Desirable: Hospitality, communication, friendliness, flexibility, enthusiasm, and love for the church.

Training is provided by: Minister for Congregational Life and other staff members as needed.

Why this ministry is important in the life of this congregation:
