| <p>The program consists of five major components:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Digital Photographs</li> <li>• Digital Fingerprints</li> <li>• Child Information and Emergency contacts</li> <li>• Dental bite impression</li> <li>• Two (2) laminated ID cards</li> </ul> <p>-- combined, provide a powerful identification and recovery tool.</p> |  <p>The child's digital photographs &amp; fingerprints, and their vital information are given to the parent or guardian on a mini-CD computer disk. The information on the disk is "AMBER ALERT" compatible.</p> |  <p>The dental bite wafer provides an impression of the biting surface, which like fingerprints, is unique to each individual. This wafer also collects enough saliva to provide a DNA sample and a source scent for trained canine search and recovery teams.</p> |
