Facilities operated by a religious organization and that do not receive federal funds for providing care for children are not required to have qualifying background screening results for all child care staff members pursuant to 210.1080.9 RSMo. Child care staff members of facilities operated by a religious organization that receive federal funds for providing care for children, with disqualifying background screening results are prohibited from being on the premises during child care hours. Facilities operated by a religious organization that receive federal funds for providing care for children, must request criminal background checks for child care staff members every 5 years, as defined in 210.1080.1(1) RSMo.
